



Deer Lake Campout 2008

Come join us for a weekend at Deer Lake Scout Reservation for a chance to learn some real life canoeing techniques, and an overnight canoe trek for some, and a good old time campout for others with lots of chances to learn and demonstrate scout skills. On Saturday morning, Mark Clifton, the Deer Park Ranger, will present a canoe skill workshop that will cover paddle techniques and strokes, proper packing of a canoe, portaging, etc. Immediately afterward, the older scouts (13 and up) will leave for an overnight canoe trip up Deer Lake, into a small river and over to adjoining Foster Lake where they will set up camp for the night.

The rest of the scouts will have time for fishing, fire building, cooking, pioneering projects, First Aid, Orienteering, or other skills.
